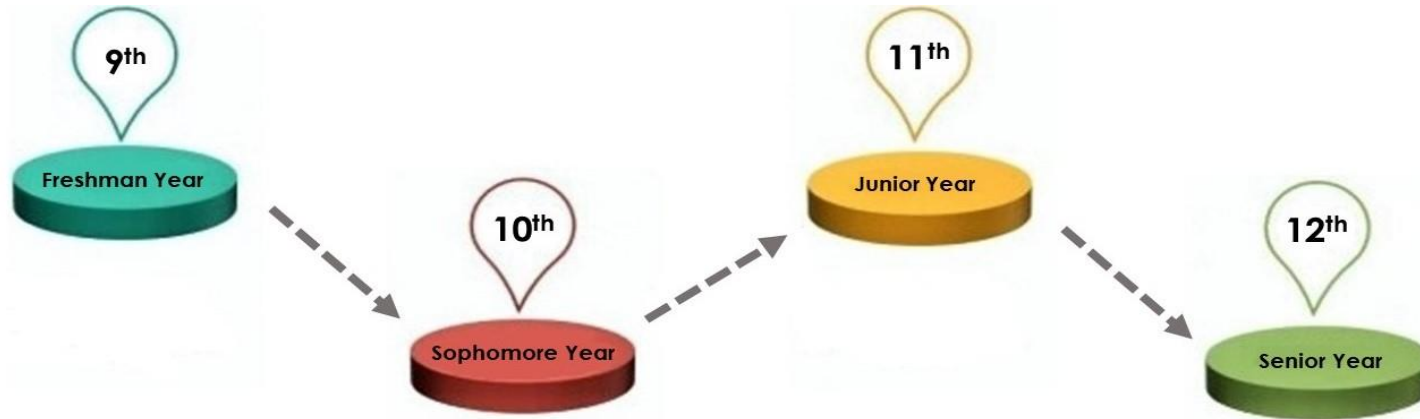


Roadmap to SAT and ACT Success!

These steps reflect how most American schools operate; please check with your school for specific details.



Freshman Year

FALL

Meet with your counselor and make a plan to complete the following classes:

- **MATH:** Algebra I, Geometry, Algebra II, Trigonometry
- **SCIENCE:** Earth Science, Biology, Chemistry
- **ENGLISH:** 4 years

Earn Bs or higher to qualify for college-level classes during 11th / 12th grade

SPRING

Take the PSAT 8/9

SUMMER

Take a test prep course for the PSAT10 & PSAT/NMSQT

Sophomore Year

OCTOBER

Take the PSAT10 for baseline data and to qualify for the PSAT/NMQST (National Merit Scholarships/National Honor Society)

NOVEMBER

Get PSAT 10 results from your school

FEBRUARY - MARCH

Take the PSAT/NMQST to qualify for National Merit, NHS, and financial scholarships

Junior Year

(ACT in Fall / SAT in Spring)

JUNE – AUGUST

- Take a practice ACT test
- Join an ACT test prep course

SEPTEMBER – DECEMBER

- Access NAVIANCE
- Take an official ACT test

JANUARY – MARCH

- Take a PSAT test
- Join an SAT test prep course

APRIL

Take an SAT or ACT test at your school for FREE

JUNE

Continue test prep courses in the ACT and SAT to practice over the summer. National Test Dates are available online.

Senior Year

SEPTEMBER - DECEMBER

Retake the ACT and/or SAT to ensure the best scores

JANUARY

Submit all scores to desired Colleges and Universities

JANUARY - APRIL

Submit all college applications
